Greetings Dear colleagues!

As we know, the basic concept of cosmetic or aesthetic surgery is different from that of plastic surgery. That's because, though it has developed into one of the plastic surgery fields, it covers all of the surgery departments including ophthalmology, otolaryngology, dermatology, general surgery, orthostatic surgery, chest surgery, OBGY and so on. For this reason, this field is at its early stage where it should be established correctly as a specialty. What's more, doctors who try to start learning cosmetic surgery desperately need a systematic and reliable training program.

But, unfortunately there is no place where they can get such programs in Asia. Now two representative countries that have regular educational programs especially in the field of cosmetic surgery are United States (AACS) and Australia (ACCS). These programs are, however, operated by general medical committees or societies like KCCS, not by the government organizations. Moreover, the most important thing is that these two programs are not for Asians but for Westerners.

KCCS has been trying to set up an educational system for the fields of Asian cosmetic surgery since 2006. KCCS hereby will launch Korean cosmetic surgery fellowship course as below.

Anyone that completes this course will be granted Diploma of KCCS and get a qualification for the examination of Korean Board of Korean cosmetic surgery depending on experience.

This will be a golden opportunity to enhance your cosmetic surgical knowledge and skills.

We hope you can join us and have a great experience with many brilliant professionals.

1. Course : Diploma

2. Eligibility requirement

i. Qualified doctors

3. Required documents

- i. A curriculum Vitae in one's own handwriting which has a photograph
- ii. A copy of a medical license (A medical specialist must submit a copy of a specialist license additionally)
- iii. An application form for regular membership of Korea Cosmetic Surgery Forum corporation (Mandatory)

'2012' Program Guide

1) **Eight week-program**(6 days per week) : Monday~Saturday

(1) Process : 8 week-program minimum on a weekly basis.

An applicant can take lessons separately such as one week or 2 weeks for convenience sake.

(But he or she must submit a plan of the class schedule before starting the courses.)

- (2) Period : January 2012~ December 2013An applicant should complete the eight week-course for minimum two months to maximum 18 months from the start date.
- (3) Training fee: 15,000 USD (excluding 10% Tax)

2) Compulsory course: Cadaver Dissection course of KCCS

Anyone who has already completed the course can be qualified but anyone else should complete the course within the training period.



Acquisition process of Fellowship

- 1) Completing the course within the training period
- 2) Test schedule : 2 days (Oral test+Written test)
- 3) Test and Diploma Presentation Ceremony
